Uniform Policy

Introduction:

The Fortuna and Athena Federation consider the wearing of uniform to be very important. It not only provides our students with an identity, it demonstrates a commitment to the values of the school and ensures a feeling of pride within the school community they attend. There is an expectation that all members of the school will strive to look their best. For students this will mean wearing the school uniform correctly when travelling to, from and within the school and when on school trips and visits. See appendix for full list.

Aims and objectives

Our policy is based on the notion that a school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school
- engenders a feeling of community and belonging
- is practical and smart
- Identifies the children with the school
- Is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be)
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by the majority of parents and carers

Equality

Our school uniform policy is inclusive and does not discriminate on the basis of gender and sex identity. As such, the school does not stipulate which items of uniform need to be worn by boys or girls. If you would like any advice with regards to this, please contact the School's Stonewall Champion via the school office.

Extremes of Weather

In extreme weather, pupils can bring boots in to wear in winter and change in to their school shoes or slippers. In summer, children will not have to wear the jumper and can wear shorts.

We do ensure we have a stock of coats, hats, gloves and scarves in school if pupils require these.

The role of parents and carers

We ask all parents and carers who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. We believe that parents and carers have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed and ready for their daily schoolwork. Parents and carers should ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair. Should the parent/carer need financial support with uniform please advise the school who will be happy to signpost or offer support where possible.

COVID guidance from September 2020 –

For Fortuna pupils; please send in the PE kit at the beginning of each half term to be kept in school and returned at the end of term.

For Athena pupils; on the pupil's class allocated PE day, pupils must come into school wearing their PE kits and will remain in them for the day. No change of clothing is to be brought in to school.



No bags or personal equipment is to be brought in to school unless agreed by the Senior Management Team.

Children will have their own-labelled water bottles or cups and writing equipment provided by and kept in school.

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school with the exception of small studs, which should be removed or covered for PE.

Athena Only

Any other jewellery requests must be discussed with the head of school and agreed.

Makeup, nail polish/nail length and hair colour/styles, can be discussed with the head of school and agreed/negotiated if the pupil is consistently adhering to the school uniform policy. This is to promote pupil's individuality. We allow children to bring slippers in to school, that can be worn in the classroom and indoor school areas for comfort.
